Establishing employment relations in militarized services

The subject of this dissertation is a theoretical analysis of issues related to establishing

employment relations in militarized services.

The preliminary hypothesis is that employment in militarized services is based on

special regulations, separate from the Act of 26 June 1974. — Labour Code. Employment

relations in militarized services do not have a unitary character and they go beyond legal

relationships understood as labour relations, which makes these issues an interesting research

topic.

This doctoral dissertation begins with reflections on the definition of the terms

"service" and "militarized service", because until now, the subject literature has lacked

uniform definitions. The following part of the dissertation focuses on the matter of

employment relationship of officers, which is typical for militarized services.

This study in the dissertation has led to the distinction of three categories of

employment in militarized services: service managers, officers and employees. The categories

have received a further taxonomy within the dissertation. The primary research method in this

paper is the dogmatic-law method, based on the interpretation of legal text. The regulations

concerning service-based relations have been of particular importance. The increasing

influence of the regulations of the Labour Code on pragmatic acts has also required the

inclusion of the code regulation of a contractual employment relationship in the comparative

aspect.

The existing literature on the topic refers only to a very few selective matters

regarding employment in the militarized services. The lack of coherent, holistic regulation in

this subject is the source of many problems. Thus, it was essential to create a thorough paper,

which covers not only the summary of previous literature about employment in the militarized services, but also issues and problems in this area that haven't been yet addressed.
