Human rights - milestones: antiquity

- Babylon: Cyrus Cylinder or Cyrus Charter (583 B.C.)
- Ancient Greece (i.a. the Stoicis, the Sophists) law of nature
- Ancient Rome



Human rights - milestones: UK

- Magna Carta or Great Charter (1215)
- Petition of Right (1628)
- Habeas Corpus Act (1679)
- Bill of Rights (1689)
- T. Hobbes, J. Locke social contract theory



Human rights - milestones: USA

- acts on rights of individuals: Virginia, Maryland (1776), Massachusetts (1789)
- US Declaration of Independence (1776)
- Constitution of the USA (1787)
- Bill of Rights (1791)



Human rights - milestone: France

 Declaration of the Rights of Man and of the Citizen (1789)

"(…) the excercise of the natural rights of each man has only those borders which assure other members of the socjety the enjoyment of these same rights"



Human rights - milestones: international

- First Geneva Convention (1864) treatment of wounded soldiers
- United Nations (1945) main goal: to protect and promote peace
- Universal Declaration of Human Rights (1948)



The concept of natural law (law of nature)

- determined by nature
- universal for each human being, regardless of time or place
- lex in corde scripta
- independent from human-made laws (positive law)



The concept of legal positivism (positive law)

- lex humana (human-made law)
- written rules that have been expressly enacted by legitimate entity
- law as a social construction
- legal certainty



The liberalism

- liberty and equality
- human being as independent individual
- role of state: night-watchman state
- civil and political rights and freedoms



The concept of social state

- fair division of goods (each according to his need)
- human being as a member of society
- role of state: interventionism
- public well-being
- social rights

- human dignity
- solidarity and common good
- distributism and social justice
