STATE'S JURISDICTION - DEFINITION

- I. capacity of a State under International Law to prescribe and enforce the rules of law
- II. it is derived from the State sovereignty and constitutes its vital and central feature.
- III. it is the authority of a State over persons, property and events which are primarily within its territories (its land, its national airspace, and its internal and territorial water) it involves the powers to prescribe the rules of law, to enforce the prescribed rules of law and to adjudicate



PROTECTIVE



PROTECTIVE

allows a sovereign State to assert jurisdiction over a person whose conduct outside its boundaries threatens the States security or significant interest of this State, or interferes with the operation of its government functions



PROTECTIVE

espionage

counterfeitig money

falsification of official documents

submitting false testimony to a consular officer.



UNIVERSAL



UNIVERSAL

in exceptional cases, the state may apply its criminal law to persons prosecuted for offenses irrespective of the offender's and victim's nationality, and irrespective of the place where the offense was committed



UNIVERSAL

based on (alleged) international law

based on international agreement



UNIVERSAL

hostes humani generis: piracy genocide, war crimes, crimes against humanity

prevention of child trafficking, terrorism, drug trafficking
